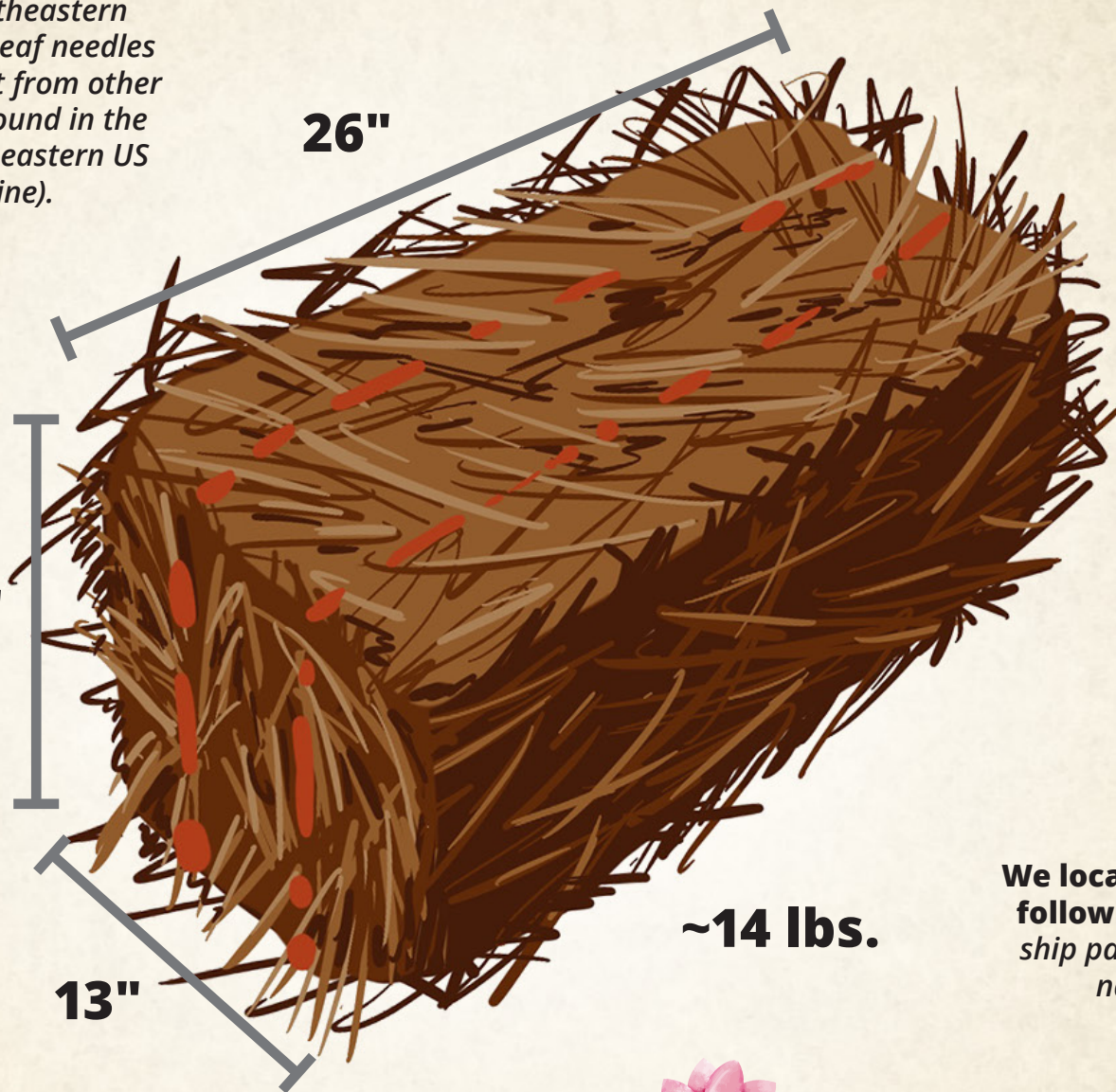


Needles Range in size from 8" to 17"

Longleaf pine needles are specifically found only in the Southeastern portion of the US. Longleaf needles are unique and different from other types of pine needles found in the Mid-Atlantic and Northeastern US (such as white pine).

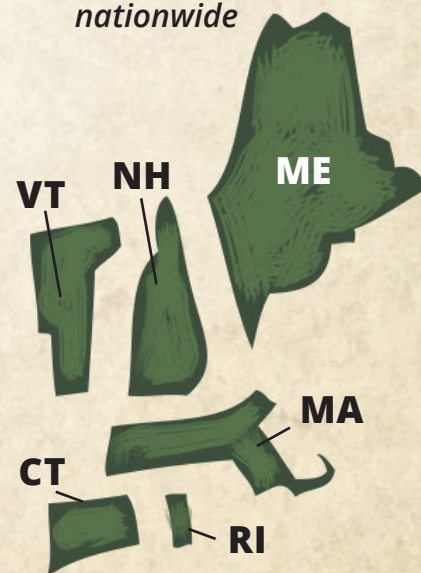
